GCSE Results 2018

At King Edward VI School (K.E.S.), where students study at least ten GCSEs, three-quarters of papers received the top 9 to 7 grades. These results once again place K.E.S. in the Top 10 of boys' grammar schools nationally and come only a week after the School's co-educational state Sixth Form was ranked ninth in the country.

Sixteen students achieved five or more grade 9s. Amongst them were **Abhimanyu Gowda** who obtained a remarkable clean-sweep of eleven, **Shavak Matalia, Cameron Mitchell and Rishi Tripathi** who obtained eight and **Felix Crabtree, Luke Davies, Joseph Lillington and Dillon Patel** who obtained seven.

Bennet Carr, Headmaster, said, "*These are very pleasing results from a fine year group. They, of course, deserve great credit for maintaining such high levels of achievement in these more substantial and challenging GCSE courses. However they have also been hugely committed to School life, achieving much in the fields of sport, music, drama and community activities.
