GCSE Results 2016

At King Edward VI School, where students typically study eleven GCSEs, there was a 100% pass rate with three-quarters of papers graded A* or A.

Thirty-eight students achieved 10 A* and A grades or better. Amongst them were **Pascal Vogiaridis** who secured twelve A*s grades, **Adam Hardy, Louis Jackson, William Jolley, Alex Matthews, Joe Pocknell** and **Richard Wood** who obtained eleven and **Tom Brook, Han Chung, Martin Edmondson** and **Michael Keane** who obtained ten.

These GCSE results when combined with the record A Level results give King Edward VI School a rank of 26th in the Sunday Times Top 500 State Schools 2016 - the highest in Warwickshire. (Indeed, K.E.S. would also be the top ranked school in Warwickshire if listed in the Sunday Times Top 500 Independent Schools 2016).

Bennet Carr, Headmaster, said *"These pleasing results are testament to the wonderful commitment shown by both the students and staff, and both groups deserve the warmest congratulations. Crucially, these results provide an excellent foundation for success in the Sixth Form, and I look forward to following our students' progress, and that of those who join us, over the next two years"*.
