Year 11 Course Summary:		
<p>The first half term of Year 11 is a continuation of work on the Prose Set Text started towards the end of Year 10. The GCSE mock examination in November provides an opportunity to learn how to consolidate a text and develop good technique in responding to literary and stylistic questions in a clear, confident and detailed manner.</p> <p>After the Prose Set Text is completed, work begins on the Verse Set Texts, which will continue through to the end of the Lent Term. Once again students have to shift out of their comfort zone as they explore a more complex and subtle written style and an even wider range of vocabulary.</p> <p>The Reading Competition is an important opportunity for students to deepen their engagement with and understanding of the verse set text by giving solo performances to an external adjudicator.</p> <p>Throughout the year boys continue to develop their translation skills into and out of Latin, particularly through Roman History (e.g. the Julio-Claudian emperors).</p> <p>Trips to relevant Classical plays, conferences or exhibitions are also often organised for students studying Latin or Latin & Greek in Year 11. In alternate years there are opportunities to explore the ancient world through travel to Italy/Greece (Years 7-13).</p>
