F1 In School National Final


- The Eclipse team of Jacob Groves, Joel Dunnett, Josh Mitchell, Carys Burchell and Adam Pateman represented the School at the National Final

Football


- Zack McKenzie was awarded a scholarship to play full-time football for Forest Green Rovers from next season




Linguistics Olympiad


