

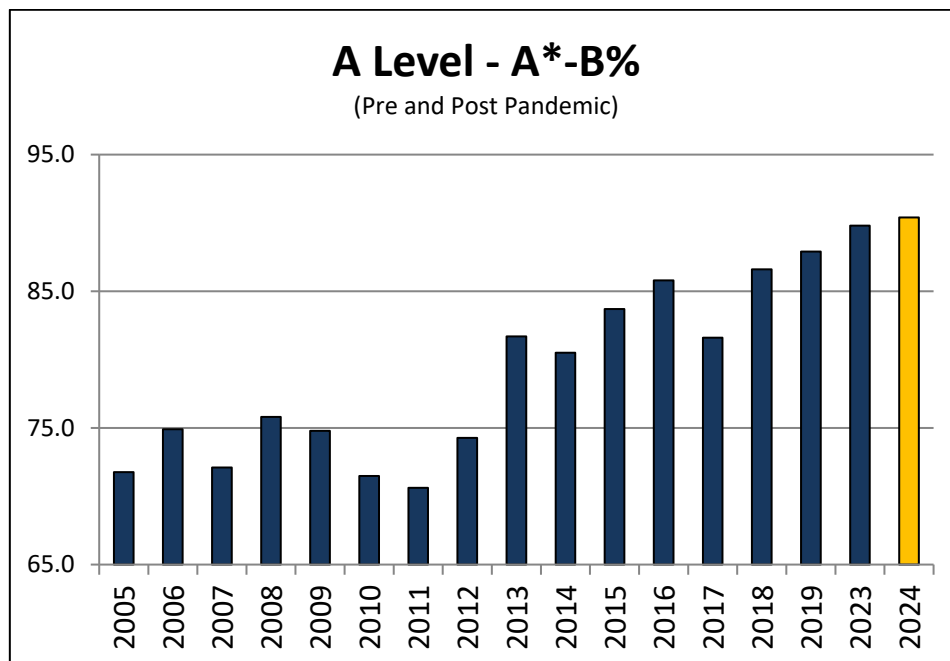

A Level Results 2024

King Edward VI School students celebrated another year of record-breaking A Level results with **90.4%** of papers graded A*/B. These results mean that K.E.S. once again has one of the country's top 10 co-educational state Sixth Forms and the highest performing Sixth Form in Warwickshire - state or independent*.



87 students obtained three A grades or better, including ten who obtained the grades to take their places at Oxbridge colleges. The stand-out performances were achieved by five students who obtained four A* grades: **David Ansell, Jonathan Flaxman, Robbie Gemmill, Eddie Mitchell** and **Ellie Morris**.
